

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (MOU)

Between KANSAS WESLEYAN UNIVERSITY and CLOUD COUNTY COMMUNITY COLLEGE

Purpose

The purpose of this MOU is to document the articulation agreement between Kansas Wesleyan University of Salina, Kansas (KWU), and Cloud County Community College, Concordia, Kansas (CCCC), for the benefit of CCCC students seeking the B.S. with a Major in Nursing degree at KWU.

Effective Date of MOU

This MOU is effective December 15, 2022. CCCC and KWU will include information about this agreement in their college publications.

General Requirements

Kansas Wesleyan University (KWU) assures the acceptance of CCCC's Associate of Applied Science: LPN-ADN Track graduate, and Generic Track graduate as a Bachelor of Science, Post-licensure R.N. to B.S. with a major in Nursing degree-seeking student.

Some KWU nursing degree programs have specific courses and grade point average requirements. CCCC graduates entering these programs must meet all additional entrance requirements for the program.

Review and Expiration Dates

This MOU will continue in force indefinitely, or until either party notifies the other of curriculum changes affecting this agreement.

Either party may terminate this agreement by written notice, by July 1st in the academic year prior to termination of the agreement

Transfer Evaluation from Cloud County Community College to Kansas Wesleyan University A.A.S. Nursing (CCCC) to B.S. Major in Nursing (KWU)

In establishing this agreement, KWU recognizes the coursework and value involved in earning the CCCC A.A.S. degree while laying the foundation enabling participating students to also complete KWU's Bachelor's degree requirements, all in a total of four years. Participating students will enroll in the following courses:
