PROGRAM ARTICULATION AGREEMENT

AAS in Nursing to BSN Bachelor's Degree

This agreement will be subject to the following provisions:

- 1. This agreement provides for the seamless transition of a student from Cloud County Community College to the RN-BSN program in Tabor College's School of Adult and Graduate Studies.
- 2. The student shall have graduated from Cloud County Community College (CCCC) with an Associate of Applied Science degree in Nursing. CCCC graduates who meet admission criteria but have not taken the NCLEX-RN exam will be given conditional admission to the RN-BSN Program. Such students must present a Kansas RN license by the third course in the BSN program.
- 3. In addition to the preparation provided by the CCCC A.A.S. degree, transfer students will be required to complete the general education requirements at Tabor College (TC). These courses can be found on the attached addendum.
- 4. Provided the student follows the sequence of both the AAS degree program and the RN-BSN degree program, the student will be able to complete the baccalaureate degree program in 124 credit hours.
- 5. Cloud County Community College student entering the stated program will be allowed to transfer up to 70 community college hours to Tabor College
- 6. The student shall have earned a minimum cumulative grade point average of 2.0 on a 4.0 scale at CCCC.
- 7. TC will develop course-to-course equivalencies, transfer guides, and degree plans necessary for each student who successfully completes an AAS degree to progress from the associate degree through the baccalaureate degree.
- 8. Cloud County Community College and Tabor College will include information about this agreement in their college catalogs and websites.

To initiate the process, the student shall submit an application for admission and official transcripts indicating that the student has met the criteria of this agreement. Tabor College's Director of Marketing and Enrollment Management will formally notify the student of his/her admission status to Tabor College.

Upon formal approval of this articulation agreement by the appropriate officials of the two institutions, each is free to publicize the terms herein. This agreement shall remain in effect until one or all of the institutions deem it necessary to modify or terminate the agreement.
