General education advances students' abilities to function in diverse and dynamic environments by enhancing communication, stimulating critical thinking, exploring modes of inquiry, developing creative work, fostering constructive attitudes regarding learning, and promoting academic literacy.

#### 5. New Business

## a. ILO discussion

Lamberty opened discussion on the current ILOs. For the ILOs with multiple parts (critical thinking, diversity, and employment) not all parts are assessed in the data collected. Some may stem from misunderstanding what "assess one of the ILOs" really means. Additional discussion occurred regarding how some of our ILOs overlap with Guiding Values. No decision was made. The list of ILOs will be sent to this committee and chairs for deeper discussions with the faculty.
