
2021-2022 tuition & fees compared to a Kansas four-year institution.


Founded in 1965, Cloud County

horizons.



Cloud County provides programs that promote individual opportunity and the region's economic health. The college also strives to put the needs of its students first with support services and career advancement opportunities that lead to student success.


