Refund Procedures

Refunds may be issued to students dropping or withdrawing from courses based on the following schedule:

Full Session Courses

1. 100% of tuition and fees, 1st through 10th class day
2. After the 10th class day, no refund

* Any refunds due to students will be made by the 20th class day.
